ARROWSMITH COGNITIVE PROGRAMMING

COGNITIVE ASSESSMENTS

Upon enrollment, students will receive a full cognitive brain profile (Arrowsmith Assessment), which assesses the student's baseline levels in a range of cognitive areas. Progress is tracked daily, and reports are provided throughout the year. Another cognitive assessment is provided at the end of the school year to assess change in under functioning areas and plan for future programming.

COGNITIVE CHANGE

It takes time and dedication for the brain to strengthen and grow neural pathways! Research shows that with repeated stimulation, the most significant cognitive change starts to occur after 9 months, with some noticeable cognitive change starting as early as two or three months.

CUSTOMIZED PROGRAM

Based on a student's assessment results, a customized program is built for each student to target their individual cognitive weaknesses. This is typically compromised of up to six cognitive exercises per school year.

Kids and teens work on these exercises for four to six blocks a day, in addition to math, language arts, integrated curricular studies, and physical activity.

TRANSITIONING BACK TO MAINSTREAM SCHOOL / THE WORKPLACE

Program length is individualized to each student, based on their rate of progress. Our goal is to help students strengthen their brains and transition successfully back to full academic programs or into the workplace or post secondary education.

SOCIAL & EMOTIONAL SUPPORT

Our schools offer a safe, inclusive environment where students can relate to others facing similar struggles and challenges. Our teachers use Dr. Marshall Rosenberg's Non-Violent Communication method to communicate with students in a way that is respectful of their emotional needs and helps foster a sense of belonging and community.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION (FOR KIDS AND TEENS)

Physical exercise plays an important role in a student's physical, emotional, social and, of course, neurological development. For this reason, physical activity is incorporated into the daily schedule. We also take our students outside for 30 minutes every day at lunch to get fresh air and exercise.

COMMUNITY & SPIRIT

Each school offers a variety of activities during the school day to foster community, spirit and friendship among the students. This can range from field trips to themed spirit days. We are always working hard to find new and exciting ways to create a fun, inclusive and motivating environment for students.

ACADEMICS (FOR KIDS AND TEENS)

EA follows the British Columbia and Washington State curriculum for Math and Language arts. Additionally, Integrated Studies of STEM, Social Studies, and Fine Arts are offered. We meet students at their current academic level with the goal of reaching grade level to transition back to mainstream schools.
